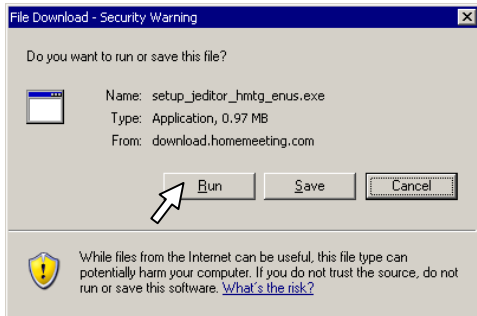




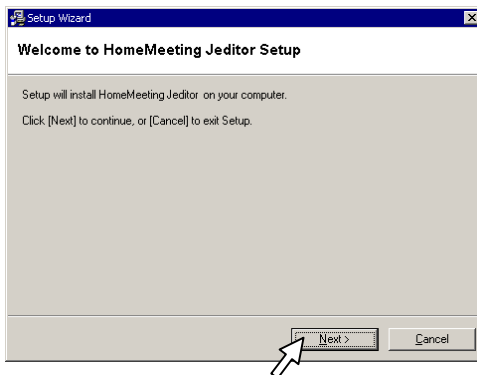
#### To install HomeMeeting Jeditor:

1. Click [here](#) to go to the official download site and click the hyperlink to download the Jeditor installation package.
2. Click **Run** to open the installation package.

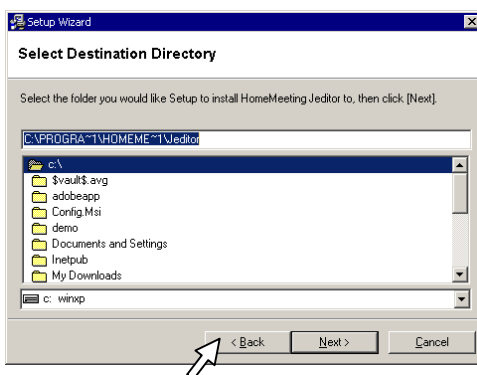


(If you see the security warning from the Internet Explorer, simply click **Run** to start installation.)

3. Click **Next** to continue the installation setup.



4. Click **Yes** to the End-User License Agreement.
5. Click **Next** to use the default installation directory and start the Jeditor installation.

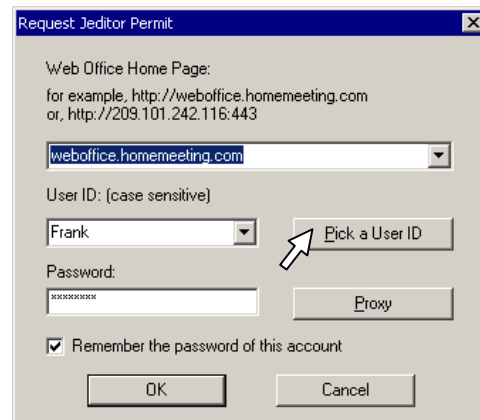


6. Click **Finish** to complete the Jeditor installation.

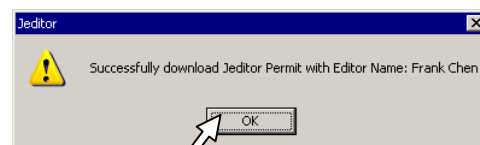
#### To request Jeditor Permit for your PC:

You need to obtain **Jeditor Permit** from a *Jeditor-Enable* HomeMeeting server to start editing a JNR file. Jeditor will authenticate users via logon credentials and examine the actual desktop or laptop hardware the user's running.

1. From the **Start** menu, choose **Programs > HomeMeeting > Jeditor > Jeditor**.
2. On the Jeditor toolbar, click **File** and select **Request Jeditor Permit**.
3. On the Request Jeditor Permit prompt, Type in the URL of a Jeditor-enable HomeMeeting server, e.g., <http://weboffice.homemeeting.com>.



4. Type your account name in the User ID field, or click **Pick a User ID** button to bring up the Pick User ID prompt. Click your user ID and click **Pick** to get back to the Request Jeditor Permit prompt.
5. If necessary, click **Proxy** button and type in all required fields on the Proxy Setting prompt.
6. On the Request Jeditor Permit prompt, type your password in the Password field and select *Remember the password of this account*. Click **OK**.
7. After Jeditor receives permit from the HomeMeeting server, click **OK** on the Jeditor prompt.



8. On the Jeditor toolbar, click **Help** and select **Show Jeditor Permit Information** to view your permit.
